



## February Activities from the Fellowship Department



### Cheesy & Creamy February Enchilada Casserole

#### Ingredients

1 tablespoon olive oil  
1 onion diced  
2 cloves garlic minced  
1 teaspoon chili powder  
4 ounces green chiles chopped  
2 ½ cups red enchilada sauce (20 oz)  
2 ½ cups cheddar or monterey jack cheese divided

1 green bell pepper diced  
1 teaspoon cumin  
1 cup corn defrosted or drained  
4 cups chicken cooked  
6 10" tortillas corn or flour

#### Instructions:

Preheat oven to 350°F.

Cut 3 of the tortilla in half.

Heat oil in a medium pan, cook onion over medium in oil until softened, about 3 minutes. Add peppers, garlic, corn, cumin and chili powder. Cook until peppers are tender, about 5 minutes. Stir in green chiles and chicken.

Place ½ cup enchilada sauce in the bottom of a 9x13 casserole dish.

Layer tortillas to cover the bottom of the pan. Top with half of the chicken mixture ½ cup cheese and ⅓ of remaining enchilada sauce.

Add a second layer of tortillas, chicken and cheese. Top with remaining tortillas, enchilada sauce and cheese.

Bake 30-35 minutes or until heated through and browned and bubbly.

### February Pudding Parfait Dessert

#### Ingredients:

One 3.9oz. package of chocolate instant pudding

One 3.9oz. package of white chocolate instant pudding

4 cups of milk    red food coloring    1 container of whipped topping, defrosted

#### Instructions:

Prepare pudding according to package instructions. Add 4 drops of red food coloring to the white chocolate pudding. Stir until well blended. Chill pudding for 5 minutes. Alternate layers of the pudding and whipped topping in clear glasses or mason jars. Top with whipped topping.



# FEBRUARY MEMORY GAME

Print the cards & then cut apart all the cards. Lay pieces flat on a table and upside down. Take turns to turn over 2 at a time. When you find the first match you get to keep the match.
