Holy Week

This is such a special week in the life of a Christian and each day of the week focuses on a different aspect of the Passion story of Christ. The week begins with the triumphal entry into Jerusalem celebrated as Palm Sunday. Followed by the clearing of the Temple and rebuking the corrupt money changers on Monday. Then Tuesday Jesus used a fig tree to demonstrate a lesson of producing good fruit and predicted the destruction of the Temple. Wednesday, they relaxed at Simon the Leper's home and here a woman named Mary anointed Jesus with expensive perfume. Thursday we celebrate the Lord's Supper, remembering that fateful night from long ago with a Maundy Thursday service at 6pm.

Good Friday, Black Friday, Holy Friday is a day we remember the trial, crucifixion, death and burial of our Lord Jesus. There is a prayer vigil at the church throughout the day you can sign up to be a part of and there is an ecumenical worship service downtown at the Jesus Wept statue at noon.

Holy Saturday we remember Jesus remained sealed within the tomb, but we will celebrate with our community in providing a free community Easter Egg Hunt at 11am. Every year we have hundreds of children who participate searching for those hidden eggs.

We will gather again on Sunday to celebrate the resurrection on Easter morning. We have three opportunities to celebrate our Risen Savior, first at the Sunrise Service at 7 am, and then at our traditional worship times at 9am and 11am.

Then comes Easter Monday, or as I like to call it, the day the minister gets to take a nap and rest after a busy Holy Week. Whatever events takes place in your life during Holy Week, I pray that your week will be filled with inspirational events that will help to make your Easter very meaningful.

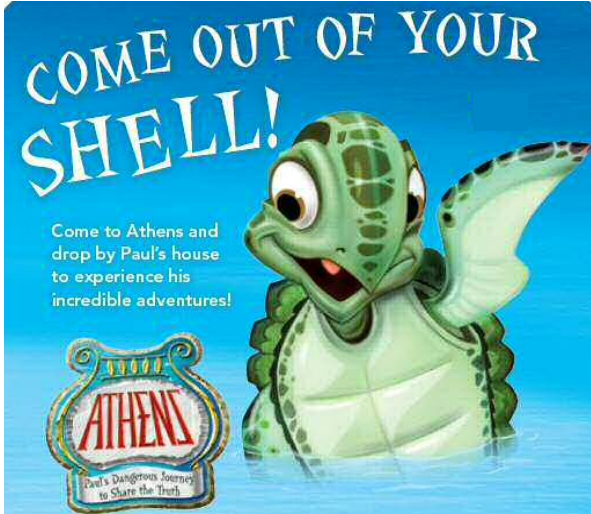
