General Assembly 2023

To borrow the words of Pat Brown, "If you have never attended a General Assembly, you need to put it on your bucket list." There is just something about gathering with other Disciples from across the Nation and Canada and worshiping together. Another mark of who we are is the way we come together to discuss the business of the General Church. We have several resolutions that are discussed and voted on. Some resolutions impact who we are such as the Design of the church and other resolutions are a "sense of the Assembly" which creates a statement of how we see ourselves as the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). As we discuss these each item, multiple points of views are expressed and listened to even when they are dissenting. We don't always fully agree on every resolution, but we discuss the issues, we listen to one another, and we vote for the best sense of who we are. In fact, that is what makes us Disciples, we listen, we discuss, and we express who we are as followers of Christ.

With that in mind, some of the resolutions that have been passed during this assembly include:

GA-2336 The Pension Fund will no longer offer health benefits as part of a healthcare package for clergy. This will ratify the ongoing practice that began several years ago and transfer funds to clergy relief.

GA-2338 The Assembly passed a resolution for Food Waste, Food Insecurity and Environmental Justice. This resolution encourages all congregations to take seriously our impact on the world around us, urging all to do what we can to reduce greenhouse emissions, and not support efforts that create "unjust, unhealthy, and unsustainable living conditions for all creatures, including humans" and that all will advocate for measures that create "just, healthy, and sustainable life on Earth."

GA-2339 passed a resolution in response to the treatment of Palestinians and to seek ways to improve relations between Israel and Palestine. The resolution includes a statement "that all people living in Palestine and Israel are created in the image of God deserving of equal dignity and their human rights." And as a denomination we will reject and condemn "speech and acts of antisemitism" but also that we oppose any act of oppression, including Palestinians, and that we reject "any theology or ideology including Christian Zionism, supercessionism, antisemitism, or anti-Islam bias that would privilege or exclude any one nation, race, culture, or religion."

GA-2341 Is another resolution passed as a sense of the Assembly resolving to oppose Christian Nationalism. "Christian Nationalism is a cultural framework that fuses a radically exclusionary form of Christian supremacist identity with the political and civic participation of a nation's citizens through the appropriation of Christian language and imagery to amass political power." This resolution indicates how Christian Nationalism is beginning to promote violent rhetoric and authoritarian approaches to civic life and public policy and these teachings are not congruent with the teachings of Christ. "THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) denounces Christian Nationalism in all its forms as a distortion of the Christian faith, and commits to opposing it wherever it appears, for the sake of the gospel and the good of the human family."

General Assembly 2023 - continued

GA-2343 Amended the Design of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) with various changes but one important change allows the business of the church to be conducted digitally. Other changes includes frequency of meetings, and the composition of the board.
