Every other year, congregations across the continent get together in one centralized location and meet to conduct the business of our denomination. Each church gets to send delegates, and those delegates get to vote on various items that shape and mold the denomination in who we are, and who we will become. The theme this year for the General Assembly happening in Louisville, Kentucky, will be the "Kindom of God Within Us, Among Us." General Assembly is not just for clergy, and there will be lots of events and activities, mission and service projects, workshops, and amazing worship services. It is a remarkable time.

The General Church that oversees our denomination does more than host a meeting every other year. This is where we discover Disciples Home Missions, Higher Education, the Christian Church Foundation, and many other ministries that we support come together and are connected through the General Church. One of those in particular, the Disciples Church Extension, is a ministry that helps churches to grow, to dream, and also helps churches to invest in their future. They offer a program called New Beginnings, which is kind of like a consulting ministry that goes to churches and helps them to take a close look at themselves and provides the tools to revision who they are as church. The group will send in a consultant to analyze who we are and the ministries we are engaged in and also provide statistical information of our surrounding community. Then they will help us to set up our own discussion groups within the church and help us to facilitate these listening groups that will help us to look at the wonderful opportunities awaiting for us down the road. The consultant's first visit will be on April 20th, and I am excited to begin a process of looking to the future of WOCC with you.
