The "Be" Team

Everyone always wants to be on the A-team. They are the ones who are typically considered to be the best of the best. The A-team is where you typically find the first-string quarterbacks and the greatest players. These are the ones that are typically called on to go out first to win the game. Some people might describe the difference between an A-team and a B-team is really the same as being great vs. being good at something. Everyone typically wants to be on that A-team for the recognition of greatness.

Interestingly, I think Jesus would encourage us not to put such a great emphasis on trying to be a part of the A-team. I think Jesus would encourage us to strive instead for the B-team, or rather, the "Beteam." In the Gospel of Mark, the disciples were caught arguing over which one of them were the greatest as though it were some competition to be the best disciple. Jesus sits them down and explains to them, "Whoever wants to be first must be last of all and be a servant of all" (Mark 9:35). So, let's consider what Jesus' "Be-team" might look like.

To begin with, our "Be-team" requires a "to be" perspective, and maybe our appeals to God might be more like this:

Help me to be a servant to others.

Help me to be a reflection of Your love, oh God.

Help me to be a manifestation of peace today.

Help me to be an example of kindness.

Help me to be patient when things are not going my way.

Help me to be understanding when others see things differently than I do.

Help me to be more merciful in dealings with others.

Help me to be faithful in prayer, worship, and practicing my faith daily.

Help me to be a good steward with my resources to glorify you, God.

I am certain that you could add more to this list concerning ways that we can strive to be better in our daily walk in faith. When you look at it this way, being on God's team is really all about being on the "Be-team." When we drop "greatest" from the idea "to be great," and remember God asks us instead, simply "to be," everything else seems to fit into place in life. If you ask me, the "Be-team" is starting to sound like the place to be when we are on God's team. No longer is the emphasis on being the greatest, but is instead a reminder of who we should be as faithful servants of God. Psalm 73.28: "But for me it is good to be near God;"


