Why We Give

There was an elderly widow who wrote a letter to God. In the letter, she wrote about her frustration with people who are doing bad things in the world and more specifically about how someone had stolen her purse, and with it her last hundred dollars for the month. She described how she needed that money to have a Christmas dinner for her friends. She sealed the envelope and addressed it, "To God." A postal worker noticed the letter addressed to God and opened it and was so moved by the plight of this lady that she shared it with coworkers. They all decided to do a collection and they collected \$96, put it in an envelope, and mailed it to this lady with a note that just said, from God.

A couple days after Christmas the same worker found another letter addressed to God from the same lady. She opened the letter and discovered the heartfelt sentiments of gratitude this woman expressed to God. But then she added this part. "God, I was surprised that the amount returned was only \$96, four dollars were missing! I bet it was those lying, thieving workers at the post office!"

We don't give because we expect something in return, we give because it is who we are. We give because it is the right thing to do. We don't do it to feel good about ourselves, nor to seek fame or recognition. Instead, we give because God first loved us, and we want to demonstrate that same love to others.

In the book and movies based on Dr. Seuss's beloved character the Grinch, the Grinch discovers there is something more to this idea of joy and happiness around the season. It is not all about the gifts as he originally thought. He thought he could steal Christmas by taking all the gifts and decorations. However, he then discovered, maybe there is a little bit more.

The Calvin and Hobbes cartoonist, Bill Watterson, noted in one cartoon the irony of what has happened to gift giving and Christmas when he wrote, "How touching to have the meaning of Christmas brought to us by cola, fast food, and beer. Who'd have ever guessed that product consumption, popular entertainment, and spirituality would mix so harmoniously?"

Indeed, many companies have greatly influenced how we look at Christmas. But really all we need to do is get back to that original story, and remember the heart of the season is wrapped in the bundle of joy not found in ribbons, wrapping paper, with pretty bows under a tree. The true joy is found wrapped in swaddling cloths and laid in a manger, a barn, a savior born to bring good news to all people in the lowliest of places. Let us not forget why we give. We give because God loved us so much that God would send this child to lead us in the right ways of compassion and love. The Grinch did not have it entirely correct, it is not that there is a little bit more to Christmas than tinsel and ribbons, there is a whole lot more to it.

May your holidays be bright, meaningful, and filled with joy this season.



This is the time of year we focus on our blessings, our family, our friends, and the gift of Jesus Christ to the world.


One gift we share each year is our special love offering to the wonderful WOCC church staff. We are so very grateful for their faithful support of our ministries!
