I also noticed where the Canadian County Disciples are applying their Lenten Series offerings to the camping program as well. We are in good spiritual company with them! Dr. Don Colbert, M.D., tells the story of Christian Huygens, a 17th century clock maker, who invented the pendulum clock. One night, while admiring his clock collection, he discovered something very important about swinging pendulums. Even if each pendulum is set to a different rhythm, they will all rather quickly set themselves in sync with each other, so that they are swinging in unison. Although he did not know why, it would be explained years later, that the largest clock with the strongest rhythm will pull all nearby pendulums in sync with itself, a process called entrainment. This discovery has an application beyond itself, and specifically in the human body: The heart has a magnetic field surrounding it that is 5,000 times stronger than the brain, and an electrical field 40-60 times stronger. The good doctor calls it a biological oscillator! When we take care of our hearts (Proverbs 4:23), when we express thanksgiving, the heart is able to hijack the brain; the motion of gratitude overwhelms the brain's emotions of fear, worry, anger, bitterness, grief, depression, etc. The physics of the heart change the biology of the body. Isn't that amazing? Mind over matter becomes heart over mind. Love rules the day! Even muscles must follow.

Let's get some collective gratitude started here at WOCC! Let's build our magnetic force and electrical field out of a multiplying love! (Jude 1:2) We are "made" alive together in Christ Jesus when we love-in -action together in thanksgiving and grace. The word "Eucharist" literally translates into "Giving Thanks Well." When we "practice communion," we are changing the world with our heart-field! Alleluia and Amen!
