# Worshipping Before We Know

A popular phrase coming out of neuropsychology today is the term "mirrored neurons." There is, of course, a warning that goes with this term; it comes out of an experimental discipline and should not be considered 'hard science.' It is important not to over-exaggerate any temporary conclusions; all we think we know about the brain is illusive and changes quickly. For example, recent studies have discovered 97 more parts to the brain than were previously identified. But, being careful and conservative, what appears to be true is that humans are 'wired' for empathy. Simply put, neurons in one brain react to neurons in another brain. In a way we do not understand completely, human neurons 'mirror' each other. There are always exceptions, but generally speaking, we co-share our feelings and our thinking in what some theologians call 'inter-dependence.' If marketing can benefit from these studies, then so can we.

What seems to be true is that we humans need to know how we feel before we can make up our minds. This leads me to think that it is best if we "worship before we know, or worship in order to know." It is not so much that we leave our brains at the door when we enter God's house to worship, but that we allow our worship to touch and influence our thinking. This is especially true during Holy Week. Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Sunrise, Easter Celebration all involve some form of worship or prayerful meditation for us at WOCC. (We do not have a Good Friday worship service here at WOCC this year, but we have scheduled prayer at 10:50 am that day). This year, let's make it a point to consider how we feel during Holy Week and how that is mirrored in our congregation. When we share our grief or our joy with others, something important happens in our community. Philo once said: "fear is grief before grief, while courage is joy before joy." Holy Week, by its very nature, leads us through an emotional journey of both grief and joy, fear and courage. Let us mirror "good grief" and "good joy" this Holy Week, as the case may be, that those who witness may see the love and grace of Christ Jesus in action!


